

## Town Manager's Report April 17, 2019

Summer roadwork—I met with Wellman Paving today to discuss a reduced price from our contract that is already in place (year 2 of 3). The meeting with the Road Committee was moved to tomorrow, at which time projects will be recommended for Board May 1 consideration.

Mass Gathering Violation—The landowner has yet to make contact with the office. This will be on you next agenda if there remains no contact moving forward.

Library— We are now hiring a part-time librarian. In the interim, the Trustees have stepped up to help clean things up, while Sallie has taken over the position for the short-term.

Recreation—The committee met and determined that they wish to proceed with a fencing repair project and potentially a storage building/batting cage roof. Both vendors contacted for pricing have asked to come back with the snow gone to take a second look. Also, given the lack of volunteers, the committee has inquired about just hiring the project out. As a result, I will be working on specifications for the project so it can be issued. The RFP won't require that any bid be accepted, but it may be a cost-effective solution to ensuring project completion this year.
