TOWN OF NORRIDGEWOCK HISTORICAL PANEL DESIGN AD HOC COMMITTEE OCTOBER 2018

BACKGROUND

Maine Department of Transportation (Maine DOT) has agreed to develop, design, and install an interpretative, historic panel to be place in Norridgewock. A panel that focuses on the history of the town will be designed and placed adjacent to the granite terrace on the north side of the river; it will have a view down to the Kennebec River.

PURPOSE

This ad hoc Committee will work in an advisory capacity to Maine DOT, its Transportation Landscape Architect, and other relevant parties in order to design a new panel. The Committee shall make recommendation to the Board of Selectmen for the final design of the panel.

STRUCTURE

The Committee will consist of seven (7) members of the Norridgewock community. Each member shall have full membership of the Committee. A chair, vice chair, and secretary shall be elected from the membership.

MEETINGS

The Committee shall meet as needed, with great consideration given to the availability of Maine DOT representatives. All meeting notices shall be publicly posted as soon as a meeting date is known. All meetings are open to the public, as provided in State statute.

FINAL REPORT

The Committee shall issue its final recommendations before March 4, 2019, so that preliminary design artwork may be provided for public viewing at Town Meeting.
