Town Manager's Report January 3, 2018

October 30 Storm Update: I have received initial notification from Somerset EMA that the President has approved the Disaster Declaration for 13 of 16 counties in Maine, including Somerset. I will have to process reimbursement requests through a federal grants system; the process is expected to be lengthy.

On December 24, we reported a 5.7pH, which is below the threshold of 6.0. We were required to report this as a violation to Maine DEP. There may have been a need for additional testing to verify that the 5.7 was an actual violation, but there was also question as to the integrity of the pH probe. We have made adjustments to mitigate future occurrences.

Amanda Taylor's organization of the Community Christmas Program was successful, once again. She was able to fulfill requests for every applicant and was overwhelmed with the community support.

Dog licenses were due December 31; the grace period ends January 31. \$25 late fee takes effect on February 1.
